Quotes from Brenda regarding Canine Body Language

"While humans are constantly trying to talk to dogs as if they were people, simultaneously, dogs are trying to talk to humans as if they were dogs. This causes endless misunderstandings, which is unfortunate for both parties."

"To add even more complexity, any particular behaviour or cluster of behaviours might have multiple intents and will vary according to context."

"Recognition of your dog's signals, as well as an ability to recognize stress-related topography, will move you significantly forward in understanding dog language. Attempting to modify behaviour (training your dog) when you don't know what your observations truly mean can be very, very difficult, and your relationship with your dog will suffer."

"If you are not taking your dog's feedback (language) into consideration when you are training, there is no partnership, no mutual conversation. There is only hoping or forcing. This is not a conversation: it is training "at" your dog, not **with** your dog."



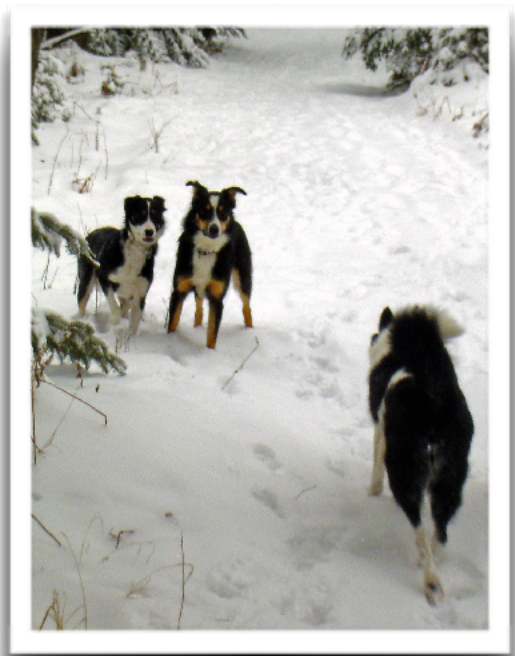

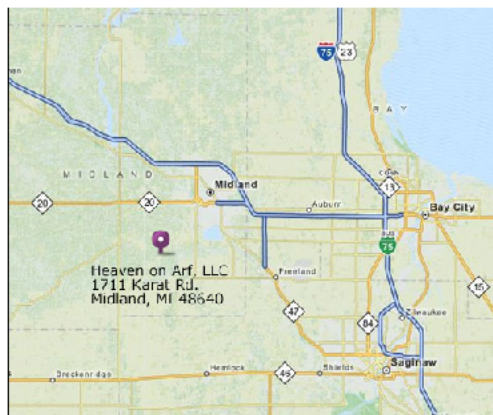
